CONTACTING YOUR CAMPER

Family and friends can write to campers c/o Camp Wesley Pines, P.O. Box 307, Gallman, MS 39077. Please ***DO NOT*** send candy or gum as campers are not allowed to keep such items in their cabins. Snacks can be purchased during canteen time for \$.75 per item. Canteens are usually twice daily. Various items can be purchased at the camp store such as t-shirts, tote bags, blankets, personal items, jewelry, caps, etc. Campers are not allowed to make or receive calls except in the case of an emergency. In case of an emergency, the Camp Director may be reached at 601-892-2341.

NOTIFICATION OF ILLNESS OR INJURY

Parents or guardians will always be notified in the event a camper becomes ill or injured.

WHAT TO BRING

Camper should bring twin size sheets, blanket, (or sleeping bag), pillow, pillow case, towels/washcloths, one piece swimsuit, beach towel, soap, toothpaste/brush, other toiletries, flashlight, sunscreen, insect repellent, casual camp clothes (no short shorts or low cut tops), rain gear, bible, spending money for camp store & canteen (all snacks are \$.75 each), note pad, pen or pencil, and stamped envelopes.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

Do not bring food items, cell phones, pagers, radios, IPODS, any kind of hand held games, alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, illegal drugs, weapons of any kind or shaving cream.

CAMPER DISMISSAL

A camper may be dismissed from the camp without a refund if he/she possesses any of the above items or if he/she becomes exceedingly disruptive, destructive or becomes a danger to themselves or others.

REFUNDS

A full refund may be received if cancellation is 7 days prior to the camp date. If less than 7 days notice is given, only half registration fee will be refunded. Cancellations on registration day will receive no refund. If a camper cannot come to camp for some unforeseen reason, pre-registration fee can be used for another camper if the office is notified two weeks prior to camp date.

PARENT'S CHECKLIST

(Please make sure all forms are completed and mailed with registration. You will need to keep this form for your records – *DO NOT MAIL IT BACK TO US*

_____ **Registration & Fees.** Please fill out all information and sign the registration form. Checks should be made payable to Camp Wesley Pines. You may choose to pay the full fee or the pre-registration fee. All fees are due no later than two weeks prior to the camp date. You will receive a confirmation of your registration by e-mail if you supply an e-mail address, or you will receive a letter by mail to verify that we have received your registration.

_____ **Health Form.** It is important that you complete all the information on the health form. This form is kept in the nurse's clinic and readily available for her to review in the event your child may need any kind of medical treatment. Parents are always contacted if that need arises. A copy of camper's current shot record *must* accompany the health form.

_____ **Roommate Request.** Roommate request must be made at time of registration. Please remember that we will do our best to honor that request, but it is not guaranteed. We will always put your child with someone in your group unless other requests are made. Rooming assignments are made in advance and cannot be changed on registration day. Please make sure you are comfortable with that rule before you come to camp.

_____ **Camper Pick-Up Form.** Please list *only* those people you think may be picking up your child. Do not sign the "Picked up" section of this form. You will sign this section when camper leaves camp.

_____ **Early Pick up.** If your child needs to be picked up early for any reason, please bring a note with you to registration and give it to the registrar.

_____ **Photo release.** The photo release is located on the front of the registration form. Please make sure to mark "yes" or "no" before returning forms.

_____ **Canteen & camp store money.** Please make sure to send money for canteen and camp store. Canteens are held twice daily and all items are \$.75. Only one candy and soft drink are allowed per canteen. Water can be purchased at any canteen. Camp t-shirts, sweatshirts, jewelry, tote bags, blankets, and other items are for sale in the camp store. The store will be open on registration day for you to visit with your camper and at various times during the week. It will also be open on the last day of camp.

Photos will be posted to an online link for you to view your child's activities while he/she is at camp. That link is: <http://photos.wesleypines.com>. When you bring up this link, **do not** login. Find the camp your child is attending and click on it. You will be asked for a "secret" password in order to view those photos. That password will be sent to you in the registration confirmation letter. When you enter that password you will be able to view the photos.

Things to bring to camp include: casual camp cloths (no short shorts or low cut tank tops), tennis shoes (flip flops are only allowed in pool area), rain gear, bible, twin size sheets (or sleeping bag), pillow and pillow case, blanket, note pad, pen or pencil, stamped envelopes, towels, washcloths, one piece swimsuit, beach towel, soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, other toiletries, flashlight, sunscreen, insect repellent, and spending money for canteen and camp store.

Do not bring cell phones, radios, IPODS, hand held games, food or drink, alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, illegal drugs, weapons of any kind or shave cream.

Meds will all need to be left with the camp nurse to dispense. ***Place meds in a zip lock bag with your child's name on the front.*** All meds must be in a pharmacy labeled container with dosage instructions or doctor's orders must accompany. Do not bring over the counter meds such as Advil, Ibuprophen, Pepto, etc. Camp nurse will provide those meds if needed.

Mail should be addressed to your camper C/O Camp Wesley Pines, P O Box 307, Gallman, MS 39077. It takes a few days for mail to get here, so it's best not to mail after Wednesday. Mail is picked up at the post office at 8:00 a.m. each morning and is delivered to camper at noon each day. **BE SURE TO PUT THE CAMPERS NAME ON THE ENVELOPE** so we will know who it belongs to. Mail can also be left at the office to be dispensed if you would like. Please mark the day you want the mail to be delivered. **DO NOT SEND** candy or gum as it is not allowed in the cabins. Campers enjoy letters of encouragement from family and friends while they are away from home. Encourage them to meet new people and make friends with campers from other areas.

Note: All forms must be completed, signed and mailed with registration fees in order for your child to be registered. Your camper will not be registered until all forms and pre-registration fees are received.
